- **Covenant**
An agreement between two people.
- **Synagogue**
A Jewish place of worship.
- **Torah**
The Jewish religious text, it is a compilation of the first five books of the Hebrew bible.
- **Mezuzah**
A parchment inscribed with religious texts and attached in a case to the door post of a Jewish home.
- **Shema**
A Jewish prayer that serves as the centrepiece of the morning and evening Jewish prayer services.
- **Affirmation**
A statement or sign that something is true
