Intent of this learning


- To understand how Christians believe Jesus' love is unconditional and eternal.

- Consider the similarities and differences between different religions and worldviews beliefs on life after death.

Key Vocabulary

- Eternity A time that never ends and has no limit.
- Vow A solemn promise or commitment.
- **Unconditional** Something that is not limited in any way.
- **Resurrection** The act of rising from the dead.
- Disciples
 A personal follower of Christ during his life.
- **Parable** A simple story used to illustrate a moral or spiritual lesson.
- **Commandment** A rule to be observed strictly.

Impact of this learning

- To be able to explain the concept of unconditional love and how that is important to Christian beliefs.
- To be able to analyse different extracts from the bible and discuss their meanings.
- To be able to make comparisons between different religions and worldviews.



Sticky Knowledge
