Key Vocabulary

- **Shema**
A Jewish prayer that serves as the centrepiece of the morning and evening Jewish prayer services.
- **Affirmation**
A statement or sign that something is true
- **Kosher**
A food that satisfies the requirements of the Jewish law.
- **Festival of Passover**
Is a major Jewish holiday that celebrates the biblical story of the Israelites escape from slavery in Egypt. It occurs on the 15th day of the Hebrew month of Nisan. In 2023, the festival of Passover is between the 5th and 13th April.
- **Seder Meal**
A ritual feast that happens at the beginning of the Passover festival.
